Responsibilities

- Excellent communication skills
- 4 hours of time weekly (mostly onsite)
- Professional attitude and business casual attire
- Ability to attend the monthly meeting at our facility
- Prior work or volunteer experience with victim services is preferred
- An outgoing, friendly personality, and a desire to help people
- Out-of-the-box thinker with new ideas regularly to promote and assist Faces of Hope
